<p>* Regarding "native" plants and trees: This indicates that the species is native to Colorado. Planting native species anywhere and everywhere in a given region can be problematic. Example 1: An aspen planted on a dry site where little supplemental moisture is available will die. Example 2: Planting of pinyon on naturally wet sites or sites where we water heavily will also lead to plant death. The focus in using native trees should be on trees that are native to the region and that are welladapted to the specific site where they will be planted.</p>																
<p>**Regarding "fire tolerance": There is no such thing as a fire proof tree. Trees with this box checked indicate that the tree can adapt or recover more easily from surrounding fire and smoke damage.</p>																
<p>***Regarding Xeric Species: Even species with Low Tolerance water needs will establish better and grow more quickly when given regular irrigation during the first 2 years of growth. As they begin to reach maturity, watering frequency can be reduced to a good deep soaking every 10 to 14 days during the heat of summer.</p>
